# Stewardship: Giving Planned for His Purpose

The Lord has commissioned His people to take the Gospel to the entire world and He has made a way so that all of us can be involved through the responsible stewardship of the resources God has entrusted to us. In addition to the gifts that come in daily from God's people, Intercede also receives

deferred or planned gifts, which are contingent on a future time and date and which often provide a stream of income to provide for loved ones and—depending on how it is setup—a future or even an immediate donation to the Lord's work. We call these creative ways of giving Planned Giving. Let's take a look at some of them.

## Charitable Gift Annuities

One of the most popular planned giving arrangements today is the Charitable Gift Annuity. Senior Christians today are discovering that gift annuities offer an excellent way to provide for their personal needs as well as help God's work. You can place money or other securities by an arrangement with Intercede.

Charitable Gift Annuities are designed to produce a high fixed rate of return to you and your spouse or survivor for life, payable monthly or in other periodic instalments. The annuity rate is locked in for life, so you need never worry that it will change. The older you are the higher rate you receive on the gift annuity. In addition to providing an income for life for you and your spouse, a gift annuity may often provide significant savings on your taxes, including an up-front immediate charitable donation receipt. Then at the end of your life, when you no longer require payments, the remainder of the gift annuity capital becomes a gift for the Lord's work. The gift annuity is more efficient than a bequest because it is not part of your estate and there are no probate fees or taxes, no executor or legal fees and no delays. All of this can save eight to 10 percent in estate settlement costs. Please contact us today for a quote.

## Endowments and Gifts in Kind

Larger amounts can be given to Intercede with a stipulation that only the interest or investment income earned on them can be used for Missions, and there is usually an end term to such agreements where the principal amount is eventually donated. The endowment provides a way for a donor to undergird a major aspect of ministry. Note: One added benefit is that gifts of Canadian securities or certain other assets when given to Charity are 100 percent tax-exempt from Capital Gains and qualify as a donation with an immediate charitable donation receipt for the fair market value of the asset.

## Life Insurance

You can support the ministry of Intercede International using your life insurance as an outright gift or as a giving instrument naming Intercede as irrevocable owner and beneficiary. This provides for a large future gift for a small annual premium now. Premiums are also tax-deductible to you.

## Your Will

Our final act of Christian Stewardship is done through a Will. This is the only way to make sure your remaining estate goes where you want it to (and not to the government) after you are with the Lord. Please consult with legal help before making a will.

**Planned Giving** provides unique possibilities to the donor to make a very substantial gift, which can ultimately benefit world missions for years to come, while at the same time providing good financial planning, provision of income and stewardship of the resources which God has entrusted to you.

Donors are always advised in every case to seek independent professional legal counsel before committing to a large gift, endowment or Will which benefits the ministry.
