Mission Statement

Intercede International seeks to establish, encourage, and strengthen an indigenous, New Testament witness for our Lord Jesus Christ among all nations by providing material and spiritual aid to Christians who are impoverished, few, or persecuted; and to encourage Christian witness and ministry to the international community in Canada.

One Body in Christ

Our Lord was born in Bethlehem and grew up in Nazareth. There He was God living on earth in a human body. He died for our sins, rose from the dead, and was exalted above the heavens. Then the Lord sent His Holy Spirit to His disciples and lived within them. God's Word tells us that all true believers "are one Body in Christ, and every one members one of another" (Romans 12:5). "If one member suffers, all suffer with it" (1 Corinthians 12:26). Intercede International carries out its vision and programs by linking God's people in Canada with fellow believers in areas of poverty and persecution.

About Intercede International

God raised up Intercede International to educate His people in Canada about working alongside indigenous missions and strategies for reaching the nations at home. It was started in Canada in 1953 and has been responsible for informing Christians about the new directions in foreign missions methodologies.

Intercede International has practised financial accountability for more than half a century. It is governed by a responsible board of business and professional leaders who subscribe without reservation to Intercede's Statement of Faith and Missionary Principles. All accounts are audited annually by an independent Chartered Accountant. Annual reports are available upon request. Intercede is a certified member of the Canadian Council of Christian Charities (CCCC) and also of the Evangelical Fellowship of Canada (EFC).



STATEMENT OF FAITH AND MISSIONARY PRINCIPLES



Our Statement of Faith...

- We believe in the unique divine inspiration and authority of the Holy Scriptures as contained in the Old and New Testaments. By this is meant a miraculous guidance by the Holy Spirit in their original writings, so that the result is the very Word of God; the only infallible rule of faith and practice. (2 Peter 1:21; 2 Tim. 3:16)
- We believe in the one God, who has manifested Himself as the Father, as the Son and as the Holy Spirit. (1 Tim. 3:16; Mat. 28:19)
- We believe that as through one man sin entered the world and death through sin, so death passed upon all men for that all have sinned. (Rom. 5:12; 6:23)
- We believe in the virgin birth and true deity of our Lord Jesus Christ. (Mat. 1:23; Col. 2:8-9)
- We believe in the death of Jesus Christ as the only true substitute and that His shed blood was and is a sufficient expiation for the sins of all men. We believe in His bodily resurrection from the dead and in His soon-coming personal return to the earth in power and great glory. (Eph. 4:10; Phil. 3:21)
- We believe that men are justified by faith and are accounted righteous before God only through the merit of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, and that all who are so justified are born anew and receive eternal life which is Christ in us the hope of glory, but that those who have not been born again shall not see the Kingdom of God. (Col. 1:27; John 3:5)
- We believe in the everlasting blessedness of the saved who are in Christ, and that God Himself will judge the lost who are outside of Christ with eternal punishment. (Heb. 6:1-6)
- We believe that all true believers are one body in Christ and every one members one of another. (1 Cor. 12:27; Eph. 2:16; Col. 1:24)
- We believe it to be the supreme responsibility of the disciples of our Lord Jesus Christ to make His Gospel known among all nations. (Rom. 1:5; Rev. 5:9).

Our Mission...

To aid, encourage and strengthen indigenous New testament Christianity, particularly where Christians are impoverished, few or persecuted; and to encourage Christian witness and ministry to the international community in North America.

We take these positions in accordance with the Word of God.

Evangelism:

Our Lord told us to go and preach the Gospel to every creature. So we must be soul-winners. We help only those groups which have a passion to win the lost.

Separation from Apostasy:

Intercede International does not knowingly belong to or assist any group that is affiliated with any body controlled by those who would suppress or deny the fundamental truths of God's Word.

Foreign Missions:

The New Testament gives priority to foreign missions. Through Christ, "we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the faith among all nations, for His name" (Romans 1:5). God's supreme purpose in this dispensation is to "visit the nations, to take out of them a people for His name" (Acts 15:14).

Who We Are

Intercede International is a Canadian Foreign Missions Board which was founded in 1953, and formally incorporated and registered as a national, tax-exempt religious charity in Ottawa in 1969.

The Mission is governed and staffed by evangelistic, Bible-believing, born-again Christians who uphold the fundamental doctrines of historic evangelical New Testament Christianity.

The By-laws and Staff Handbook require that all board and staff members subscribe

without reservation to the doctrinal statement and missionary principles of the Mission.

Intercede International has been a certified member of the Canadian Council of Christian Charities (CCCC) and the Evangelical Fellowship of Canada (EFC) since 1986.
